- If applicable, instant discount amount (itemized after taxes)
- Balance due of zero, paid-in-full stamp, or payment terms

### Additional Equipment Requirements

- Customer must use natural gas for all equipment installed.
- Furnace must be primary heat source for home's living space and be a sealed combustion unit. Dual fuel systems are not eligible.
- Boilers must have a modulating burner and include outdoor air temperature reset control.
- Chimney liners must be installed where an atmospherically-drafted appliance remains in the existing chimney after a sealed combustion unit has been installed. A sealed combustion unit must provide combustion air from outside the home. Installers must also complete the flue closure protocol when a sealed combustion unit has been installed. If a power vented natural gas water heater is installed, the installer must complete the flue closure protocol as well.

## Terms and Conditions

**Eligibility:** This Residential Rebate Program ("Program") offer provides financial rebates for the purchase of new, installed qualifying equipment and is not dependent on the purchase of any other equipment unless indicated. Offer is valid only for Vectren Energy Delivery of Indiana ("Vectren") natural gas residential customers. Location of installed equipment must have Vectren natural gas service in Indiana. Customer must provide their Vectren account number. Businesses must provide correct taxpayer identification or social security number. Rebate funds are limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Offer is valid for equipment and products purchased and installed between April 1, 2012 and December 31, 2012. Customers must be a Vectren residential natural gas account holder at the time of equipment purchase and installation. Rebates may not exceed the total purchase price of the energy efficient equipment. Eligible costs for rebates include: Materials, Equipment, and External Labor. Allow up to 8 weeks to receive your rebate. Incomplete applications cannot be processed. Failure to complete the rebate application in full and provide the required supporting documentation will either delay the payment process or result in your application being denied. Receipt of an application does not guarantee payment of a rebate. The Program is not responsible for items (i.e. application, supporting documentation, rebate checks) lost or damaged in the mail. Only single family dwellings or multi-family dwellings of 12 units or less are eligible for the rebates included in this application. Similarly, rebates can only be paid to one person or entity (homeowner or trade ally, not both). Vectren will only pay one rebate for each product installed. All equipment installations are subject to verification by the Program to ensure the equipment is properly installed and operating. Customers should verify with Vectren that their natural gas pressure is adequate for any gas-using equipment being installed.

**Program Qualifications:** High-efficiency equipment must be purchased new. Resale equipment, new parts installed in existing equipment, or equipment that is leased, rebuilt, rented, received from insurance claims, received from a warranty or won as a prize does not qualify. Equipment installed must conform to all applicable building, local, state, and federal codes, standards, ordinances, regulations and manufacturer's specifications. All requirement documentation must be submitted within 60 days of installation of equipment.

**Verification:** Vectren reserves the right to verify sales receipts and/or installations of equipment and that the equipment installed meets program requirements before issuing rebates. Participants must

allow, if requested, subsequent site visits by an authorized Program representative to verify installation and operability of the equipment.

**Program Modifications:** Vectren reserves the right to alter or discontinue these rebate offers at any time without notice.

**Disclaimer:** Vectren does not guarantee that energy efficiency equipment purchased and installed or services provided through this Program will result in energy and cost savings. Vectren reserves the right to deny or limit any rebate request. Subcontractors are contractually bound to maintain this information in the strictest of confidence.

**Representation:** Making false statements on any Vectren rebate application is punishable by law.
